To whom it may concern,

I am pleased to write in support of Six Foot Something Production's application for an Australia Council for the Arts / Arts Projects for Organisations grant to produce the work *Geek Cuisine* for Dream Big Festival (May 2023).

The proposed work has the potential to create many points of cultural engagement and connection with people not usually known for their interest in the operatic art form. The creation of an opera specifically targeted at family audiences will help to expose young people to the art form of opera—inspiring future audiences and performers. In addition, *Geek Cuisine* will provide an opportunity for Australian writers, creative teams and performers to work in the genre, to push its boundaries and experiment with the form.

However, the development and presentation of such works is one of the most expensive undertakings to which a company can commit. A new collaboration between our two companies is long overdue. We look forward to joining with Six Foot Something to reimagine what opera can be.

Geek Cuisine is an exciting opportunity to foster the social connectedness that comes from attending arts and culture with like-minded people from diverse backgrounds. It will provide an ideal opportunity for cross cultural artistic dialogue and allow our two companies to develop our presence and resonance in South Australia.

Geek Cuisine has the possibility of breaking down some of the perceived barriers of entry to our artform; to demonstrate that opera is accessible for a broad range of audiences. State Opera commends this collaboration as worthy of your serious consideration.
